Synopsis:

Ordinance clarifies the regulation of noise within the City of Carmel.

d. <u>Second Reading of Ordinance Z-634-18</u>; An Ordinance of the Common Council of the City of Carmel, Indiana, Amending Owners' Association Standards and a Variety of Definitions in the Unified Development Ordinance; Sponsor(s): Councilor(s) Campbell & Rider. Sent to the Land Use and Special Studies Committee (9/13/18 Meeting Date).

Synopsis:

This ordinance adds a required inspection of common area improvements prior to a developer turning over control of the owners' association to property owners. This ordinance also amends a variety of definitions in the Unified Development Ordinance.

a. <u>First Reading of Ordinance D-2429-18</u>; An Ordinance of the Common Council of the City of Carmel, Indiana, Authorizing and Approving an Appropriation of Funds From the Operating Balance of the General Fund to the 2018 Carmel Department of Community Services Budget; Sponsor(s): Councilor(s) Carter, Kimball and Worrell

Synopsis:

Appropriates funds to the 2018 Carmel Department of Community Services budget that were received by the City as refunds from the Hamilton County Treasurer.

b. <u>First Reading of Ordinance D-2439-18</u>; An Ordinance of the Common Council of the City of Carmel, Indiana, Authorizing and Approving an Additional Appropriation of Funds From the Operating Balance of the General Fund to the 2018 Carmel Fire Department Budget; Sponsor(s): Councilor(s) Carter, Kimball and Worrell

Synopsis:

This ordinance appropriates funds to the 2018 Carmel Fire Department budget that were received by the City as reimbursements for the performance of public safety functions at public events. It also appropriates funds received from a FEMA grant for additional officer training classes into the 2018 Carmel Fire Department Budget.

a. <u>**Resolution CC-09-17-18-01**</u>: A Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Carmel, Indiana, Approving a Transfer of Funds Within the 2018 Carmel Street Department Budget; Sponsor: Councilor Rider.

Synopsis:

Transfers \$300,000 from various line items within the 2018 Motor Vehicle Highway Fund budget into the Grounds Maintenance line item within the 2018 Motor Vehicle Highway Fund budget and the Other Contracted Services line item within the 2018 Street Department Budget.

b. <u>Resolution CC-09-17-18-02</u>: A Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Carmel, Indiana, Approving a Transfer of Funds Between the Grant Fund (CFD) (#900) and the General Fund (#101); Sponsor(s): Councilor(s) Carter, Kimball and Worrell

Synopsis:

Transfers \$102,458.28 from the Grant Fund (CFD) (#900) to the General Fund (#101) so that grant funds received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency can be used to pay for additional officer training.

c. <u>First Reading of Ordinance D-2440-18</u>; An Ordinance of the Common Council of the City of Carmel, Indiana, Amending Chapter 2, Article 5, Section 2-179 of the Carmel City Code; Sponsor(s): Councilor(s) Carter, Kimball and Worrell
